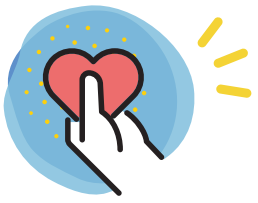
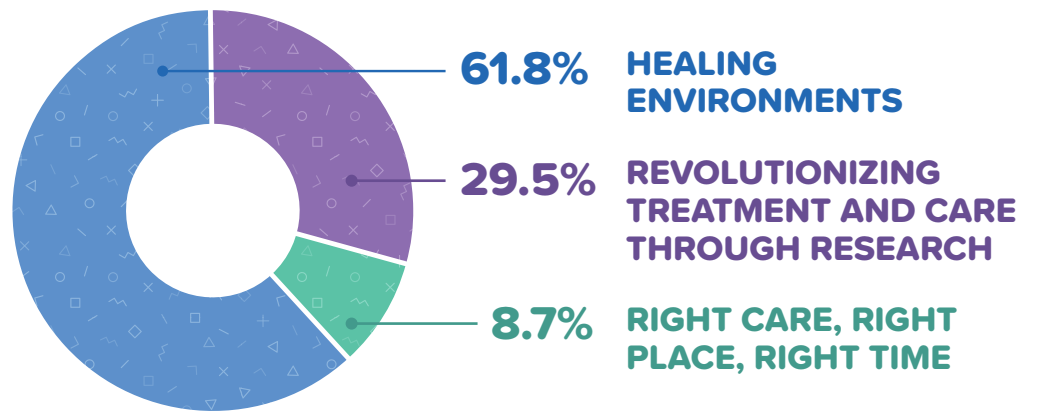
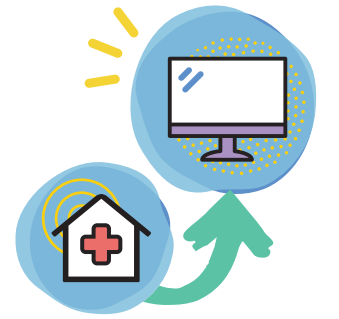


During 2020, a year like no other, Canada's 13 children's hospitals continued to put **children first**.
